Participating youth will receive:

- Tutoring, study skills training and instruction to continue education
- Alternative secondary school offerings
- Paid work experiences
- Occupational skills training
- Leadership development opportunities
- Financial literacy training
- Entrepreneurship training
- Adult mentoring

In order to enroll in the program, the youth must meet the following qualifications:

- Milwaukee County resident aged 16-24,
- Not attending any school, and
- Meet one or more additional conditions:
 - School dropout;
 - Holds a secondary school diploma or equivalent and is low-income and is basic skills deficient or an English language learner;
 - Subject to the juvenile/adult justice system;
 - Homeless, runaway, in foster care or aged out of the foster care system, or in out-of-home placement;
 - Pregnant or parenting;
 - An individual with a disability;
 - Low income person who requires assistance to enter or complete an educational program or to secure and hold employment
