The Multi-Craft Core Curriculum (MC3) - High School Equivalency Diploma (HSED) class is a joint effort by WRTP/BIG STEP and Literacy Services of Wisconsin to provide determined individuals the chance to earn their HSED, while obtaining valuable construction industry skills. MC3 is a North America Building Trades (NABTU) nationally recognized curriculum and certification. The MC3 instruction, carried out by WRTP/BIG STEP staff, provides participants with an integrated, seamless path to connect to one of the many construction career pathways* on the horizon in Southeast Wisconsin. The HSED portion, administered by Literacy Services of Wisconsin staff, is tailored to individual students' needs and builds upon the strengths of the students.

Terrance was working through temp agencies, but found it hard to find a decent wage and wasn't sure how to get the skills for better paying jobs. He first heard about WRTP/BIG STEP a few years previously, but without a high school diploma, the opportunities were limited. Once he heard about the MC3/HSED Impact 100 program, he came back and applied. *“What I hoped to gain from the experience was my education, and a better career, and the ability to make a better wage to be able to support myself and my family.”* Upon completion of the MC3/HSED training class, Terrance began his construction career as a Tile Setter Helper on the Bucks Arena project. He is working towards his goal of becoming an apprentice.
